- 5. a list of the patronages of the Saint
- 6. a story about this Saint (an event, a miracle, etc.)
- 7. a custom or tradition that explains how the Saint or Patron's feast day is celebrated in the country
- 8. your name, grade, and your source at the bottom of the PDF
- an attractive and readable presentation of the information, free of grammatical errors
