Selecting Pronouns

Pronouns are words that take the place of nouns. Subject Pronouns take the place of the subject of the sentence.

Singular Subject Pronoun	Spanish	Plural Subject Pronoun	Spanish
I	yo	we	nosotros, nosotras
you (informal)	tú	you (familiar)	vosotros, vosotras
you (formal)	usted	you (formal)	ustedes
he, she	él, ella	they	ellos, ellas

Helpful hints:

1. If you are talking about someone, use he or she as the pronoun.
2. If you are talking to someone, use you as the pronoun.
3. You can be singular or plural. If the you is one person, use tú or usted. If the you is a group of people, use ustedes or vosotros.
4. If you are talking about a group of people, use they as the pronoun.
5. If you are talking about a group of people, including yourself, use we as the pronoun.
