## **Selecting Pronouns**

Pronouns are words that take the place of nouns. Subject Pronouns take the place of the subject of the sentence.

Singular Subject Pronoun	Spanish	Plural Subject Pronoun	Spanish
I	уо	we	nosotros, nosotras
you (informal)	tú	you (familiar)	vosotros, vosotras
you (formal)	usted	you (formal)	ustedes
he, she	él, ella	they	ellos, ellas

## Helpful hints:

- 1. If you are talking about someone, use he or she as the pronoun.
- 2. If you are talking to someone, use you as the pronoun.
- 3. You can be singular or plural. If the you is one person, use tú or usted. If the you is a group of people, use ustedes or vosotros.
- 4. If you are talking about a group of people, use they as the pronoun.
- 5. If you are talking about a group of people, including yourself, use we as the pronoun.
