

Vamos a escribir 1 - Chapter 3

Write a well-organized, grammatically correct paragraph about things you do at school or after school, using the vocabulary from Chapter 3. **Do not use an online translator.** Be sure to edit your writing:

- Does your paragraph respond to the prompt?
- Is your paragraph organized?
- Does it include a wide variety of vocabulary, including one irregular verb (ir/dar/estar)?
- Do all the subjects and verbs agree?
- Do the nouns and adjectives agree? (If you describe a feminine activity, is the adjective feminine?)
- Do the articles and nouns agree? (If you are using a feminine word, did you use la or una with it?)
- Did you use correct sentence structure? (words in right order, no apostrophes, nouns before adjectives, etc.)
- Did you check for spelling errors and missing accent marks?

Example:

Emilio estudia en un colegio privado en Barcelona, España. Es un colegio mixto para muchachos y muchachas. Los alumnos del colegio llevan uniforme a la escuela. Los muchachos llevan pantalones azules y camisas blancas. Las muchachas llevan faldas azules y blusas blancas. Emilio y sus amigos van al colegio a pie porque sus casas están muy cercas de la escuela. En la mañana, Emilio estudia matemáticas y inglés. En la tarde, él va a la clase de geografía. Después de las clases, Emilio y sus amigos navegan la red.
